First Things First:








If you have a SMARTboard in your classroom:

-  Your system should have already been checked to make sure everything was connected correctly.
-  Just turn on your computer, then your projector.
-  Some of you may have to change something in settings that selects dual displays (check with your CIT)
-  Then either open a SMARTbook Notebook file you have on a CDrom or have downloaded from the internet.
-  Or create one of your own! (We'll get to that!)

First Things First:



If you want to use your personal laptop:

-  You can go to the SMARTboard website (see the list of resources) and download the software for free.
-  Find the serial number for your SMARTboard. (check in the "Home/Help and Support/Activate Software")
-  Enter it into the software on your laptop and you are good to go!
-  Now you can work on your Notebooks at home!
-  If you have an Apple laptop, you will need an adaptor to connect it at school.

Invest in a flash drive! Notebook files are large and take up a lot of space on the H Drive.

-  You can play games to review. (Sol-Mi La Game)

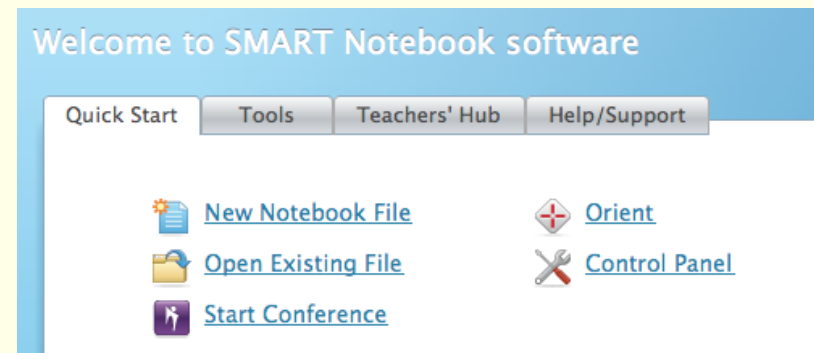
First Things First:





Orient the Board

 Look for the blue square with a white CD symbol on it.

 This should open up the Welcome Center (you can set this to open every time you open up a SMART Notebook).



 Click on "Orient" and tap on the red plus signs.

 Now you are ready to begin using your board!

Let's Explore the Basic Tools:

- ★ Do you have the "SMARTboard floating tool bar" If not, all these can be found in the tool bar at the top of the page.
- ★ Your arrangement may look differently than mine.

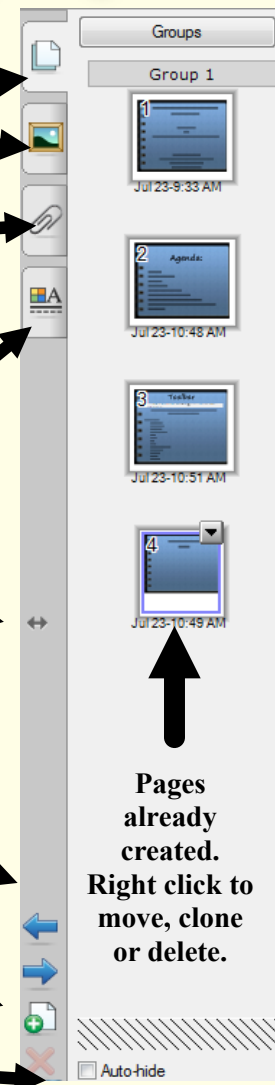

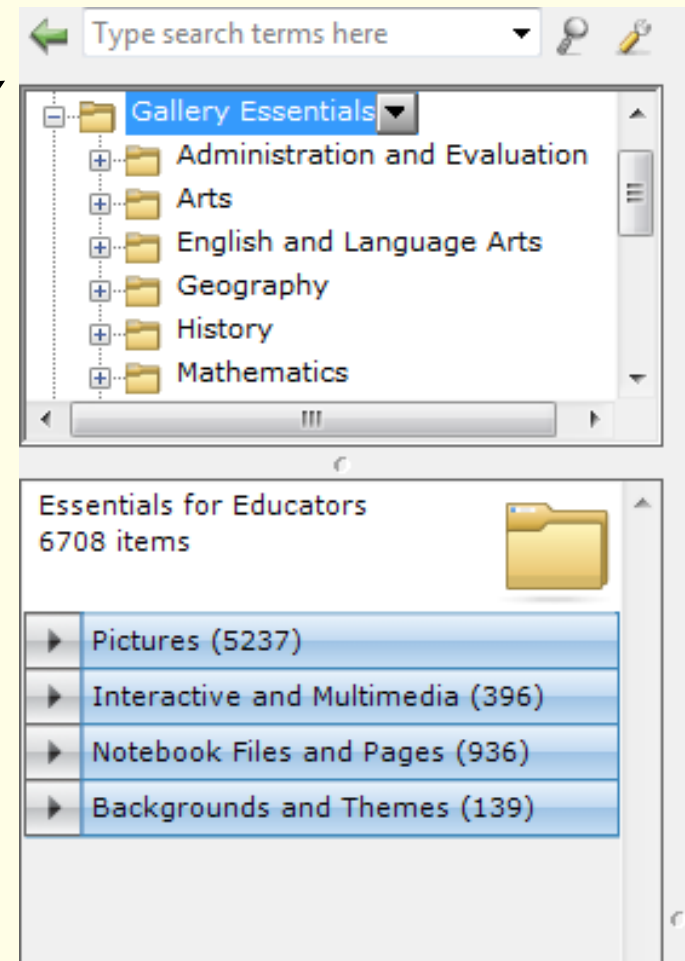
